## A1 & A2 Covid Update

Archives I is now in medium transmission. Archives II is now in high transmission. Per NARA leadership:

Starting on Monday at A2: all occupants must wear face coverings at all times, and occupancy limits will be reinstated for elevators and enclosed spaces throughout the facility. Onsite volunteer programs are suspended and onsite food service will not be available. At both facilities, researchers must present vaccine attestations and individuals who are not fully vaccinated must present new, negative COVID-19 test results to access the facilities.
